5G news coverage during Valladolid's Holy Week

Objective: Carry out informative coverage, in real time, through TV cameras connected with 5G technology.

Description: Telefónica and CyLTV carry out the first 5G direct during Holy Week

Castilla y León Televisión and Telefónica España have made the first 5G live connection during Holy Week in Castilla y León. It is the first time that this state-of-the-art mobile technology has been used to broadcast live processions. In this case, that of 'El Encuentro', one of the most emotional and crowded of the Passion Week of Valladolid, which took place in the setting of the Plaza Santa Cruz.

The second live connection with 5G took place on Holy Thursday in the surroundings of the Cathedral in the so-called 'Penance Stations' of the different brotherhoods of the city.

For live connections, Telefónica Spain has connected with 5G technology a CyLTV camera through a backpack of the company Aviwest equipped with 5G modems, which allows direct without having to move a mobile unit to the place from which the broadcast is broadcast.

The high bandwidth and low latency of communications that allow 5G AVIWEST equipment offer to give this mobility and autonomy to TVCyL cameras, avoiding cable runs and the installation of mobile units.

The speed and effectiveness of AVIWEST has made it possible to offer a live connection with high quality on the commercial 5G deployment of Telefónica and greatly reduce delays. The project has had the collaboration of NRDmultimedia as official distributor of AVIWEST in Spain.
